

CFC General Information

Check-in:

- Check-in is between 5:00pm 6:30 pm (do NOT arrive early). Look for the CFC banner and signs. If you arrive late, please check-in at the Dining Hall.
- Park your car in the designated parking area only. Do not unload until checked in.
- Upon check-in you will receive a welcome package with your team and cabin assignments, T-shirts, camper roster, program schedule, kitchen duty assignment, name badges and other camp documents.
- Once checked in, Greylock staff will transport you and your belongings to your cabin in a golf cart.
- Please submit the following signed papers upon check-in:
 - o Camp Greylock WAIVER AND RELEASE form.
 - o Camp Rules.
 - o Youth Dorm Residency Policy (if applicable).
- Dinner is served in the Dining Hall at 6:00 pm. Campers are asked to wear their badges to dinner. An orientation (ice breaking party) will be held right after dinner. So please stay around. Kids ice breaking party will be held at the hockey ring.

What to pack:

- Sheets, towels, pillows, blankets and sleeping bags.
- Lots of T-shirts, shorts, socks, and a few long sleeves. Mornings and evenings can be chilly.
- Personal hygiene items. Shampoo, soap, hair dryers, towels, tooth brush, ...
- Sneakers, sandals, bathing suits, goggles, beach towels, insect repellent, sunscreen, and flashlights.
- Personal sporting equipment such as tennis rackets/balls, golf clubs/balls, badminton rackets/birdies, baseball gloves, roller blades, fishing gear, exercise mat, ping-pong paddles, ... etc.
- Dancing shoes and attire for the square dance and dance party.
- Musical instruments, costumes or props for the talent show; Karaoke VCD's and movie DVD's, chess, playing cards, Mah-Jong, board games, rain gear for rainy days, ... etc.

Campsite Info:

- All cabins have bunk beds with foam mattresses. There are electrical outlets and overhead lighting in each cabin, but no chairs.
- Each cabin has a rest room and vanity. Shower rooms are located in central locations of the campsite.
- Canoes, sailboats, and kayaks are available to CFC campers. Golf courses and driving ranges are nearby.
- Coin operated laundry facilities are available in Lee.
- Tanglewood is ½ hour away. A shopping outlet is right off Rte. 90. Campers may organize concert and shopping trips on their own.

Visitors:

- Guests of campers must regsiter with the CFC Asistant Registrar Guang Mei (梅广) upon arrival
- Day guests are not allowed to participate any camp sport activities so they pay meals only; \$5 for breakfast, \$10 for lunch and \$15 for dinner.
- Overnight guests are charged, \$90/per person/per day (all ages) if pre-register and stay less than 3 days \$110/per person/per day without pre-registration or if stay more than 3 days, which includes three meals, all activities, access to camp facilities and night accommodation.
